IPM

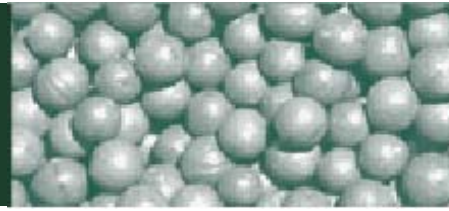
